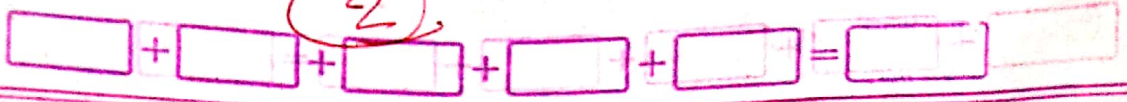
A All plants need sunlight, water and air to grow.

A No, air does not have colour, smell or taste.

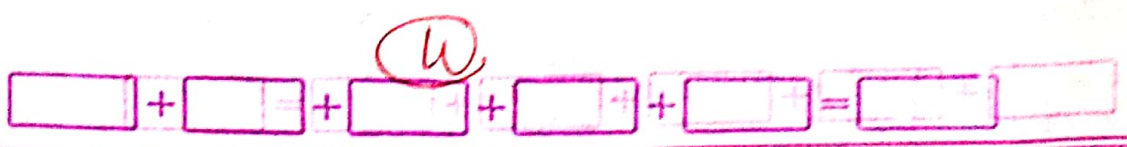
